Park Morton

The New Communities Initiative (NCI) is a District government program designed to revitalize severely distressed housing into vibrant mixed-income communities. NCI's approach addresses both the physical architecture and human capital needs of a neighborhood. Park Morton was incorporated into the Initiative in 2008.

The Avenue, Park Morton

Location

Located in the northwest quadrant of the city in Ward 6, with close proximity to the Georgia Avenue-Petworth neighborhood and Howard University, Park Morton is bounded by Georgia Avenue to the west, Park Road to the north, Warder Street to the east, and Lamont Street to the south.

History

The Park Morton community sits within one of the most diverse neighborhoods in the city with a legacy of being a center of African-American commerce and activity along 7th Street and Georgia Avenue.

Project Description

The DC Housing Authority, in partnership with the District, will select a master developer at the end of 2014 to move forward with the redevelopment of the 174 two-bedroom units that currently make up the Park Morton public housing complex. Through New Communities, the housing will be transformed into a vibrant mixed-income, mixed-use community where residents have access to quality housing, economic opportunities, and human services.
